2E1 THE 2CENE

Consider the background your miniature needs. We mostly shoot on white — a simple sheet of paper should do the trick.



LIGHT IT UP!

Place light sources on either side of you model. If you're serious, invest in daylight lamps.



THE GOLDEN ANGLE

has a golden angle, a viewpoint that best captures the essence of the model.



CROP IT

Get close enough to capture detail without clipping off details around the edges.



FOCUS!

Make sure your camera is focused on the right point. If you plan to submit them for viewing online, check them on a
